

Temple Isaiah High Holy Days 5772 (2011) Childcare Registration Form

This year, Temple Isaiah will again offer childcare for infants through children in grade 2 both on Rosh Hashanah (Thursday, September 29th) and on Yom Kippur (Saturday, October 8th) for the duration of the 8:30 AM and 11:30 AM Congregational Services. Infants, toddlers, preschoolers and all children up to and including 2nd grade are welcome!

Where and When: Childcare will be in the downstairs classrooms of the school both on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Children must be picked up at the conclusion of each Congregational Service.

Supervision: Both adults and LEFTY member volunteers will be involved in supervising your children. There will be one-on-one supervision for children under age 2. Please remember to bring an infant seat, walker, playpen or special comfort toys if your child needs any of these items.

Snack: We will provide a nut-free snack. If you feel that you must send in a snack for your child(ren), please ensure that it is nut-free, in consideration for those children with allergies. If your child has allergies to any foods, please be sure to indicate such allergy on the form below.

Medical/Special Needs: All of our childcare providers are volunteers. If your child has medical or other special needs, you should contact our childcare coordinator - Ilene Benghiat, ibenghiat@verizon.net or 781-863-2285 - in advance to make arrangements.

Volunteer Power: Childcare is run *by* and *for* Temple families!

Please plan to volunteer for at least one block of time (approximately 1 hour). Only with many volunteers will everyone needing childcare be adequately accommodated. (This may be an opportunity to meet your future LEFTY - Isaiah's high school youth group - babysitter!)

Registration: We encourage you to register for childcare online at www.templeisaiah.net, or by completing the form below and returning it to the Temple with your ticket request. While there is no charge for childcare, you must register to reserve a space so we can plan for adequate coverage. **And Please plan to volunteer to help!**

Check-in & Pick-up: Please drop-off your child at the Childcare registration desk in the front lobby, no earlier than 11:15 AM. We will confirm your registration information and assign your child(ren) a classroom or individual caregiver. For pickup, if you are attending the 8:30 AM Congregational Service(s), return to the Childcare registration desk by using the backdoor to the Library located outside the coat room by the Sanctuary entrance doors. Proceed through the library to the front lobby to pickup and sign out your child. This greatly alleviates traffic congestion between the end of the 8:30 AM and beginning of the 11:30 AM services.
